What does Soldier On do to support veterans and their families?

Soldier On is a national organisation that supports serving and ex-serving Australian Defence Force personnel and their families. Our services aim to HELP individuals build resilience and create, and expand, meaningful connections with family, community and employers through:



Health and wellbeing: Psychology, social activities and programs services, sporting and exercise activities and programs and service initiatives.



Employment and transition: Transition services, employment support, and assistance with career development.



Learning: Learning and education and training programs, vocational training.



Participation: Social activities and programs focused on connections with family, friends and the broader community, volunteering and sports programs.

What is the Pathways Program?

The Soldier On Pathways Program provides employment support, education and training opportunities, to help veterans and their family members throughout their career transition, to secure meaningful, long-term employment.

What is The Pledge?

The Pledge is a voluntary standard that is at the core of the Soldier On Pathways Program. The Pledge enables organisations across Australia to signal their support for ex-service personnel and their families by creating veteran-friendly workplaces and recognising the skills and attributes they offer.

The Pathways Program supports any person who has served in the Australian Defence Force for any period of time since 1990, and their immediate family members. By providing practical help such as resume

development, assisting with job applications, providing career advice and connections to job opportunities, Soldier On helps support successful transitions.

Soldier On works directly with Pledge companies to provide advice about employing and recruiting veterans and their families, build meaningful connections, and facilitate channels for quality job applicants. By signing The Pledge, organisations can easily connect with the diverse, highly-skilled talent pool that is the Australian veteran community.

Ultimately, Pledge signatories will play an important part in ensuring Soldier On can achieve its core mission: enabling veterans and their families to thrive.

The Pledge levels

The Pledge requires organisations to demonstrate their commitment in three core areas:

- · Recruitment;
- Retention (including training and development); and
- Workplace culture and communication.

Examples of recruitment, retention and workplace culture processes, strategies or systems are included on following pages.

Recruitment

Over 375,000 personnel have served in the ADF since 1990, and more than 1 million Australians are part of the veteran community, resulting in a massive talent pool to recruit from.

Pledge Partners will provide feedback about participants to further support them with career goals and applying for future roles. HR contracts will also promote Soldier On's message within the company. They will facilitate strong relationships between company recruitment teams and Soldier On to provide support and advocacy for candidates in the Pathways Program.

Examples include:

Attending or hosting Soldier On Pathways Events

Recognising or flagging Soldier On candidates or applicants throughout their application process or portal

Ensuring any Soldier On submitted applicant who secures an interview will receive feedback

Developing and implementing a veteran recruitment strategy

Creating veteran community supportive recruitment portals, materials or collateral, separate to transition careers information

Engaging in resources or information to promote military skills transfer to your organisation

Provide training and support to HR and recruitment teams within your organisation, to enable them to translate and support veteran applications

Update job ads to include Defence-friendly language and share roles on the Soldier On Job Board

Create and promote successful veteran employment stories, which can occur in partnership with Soldier On and through social media

Create resources and information to support career planning for current serving personnel

Employ a dedicated veteran recruiting team, staff, council, working group or committee to provide lived experiences and knowledge to assist veteran and family recruitment



Retention, including training and development

Retaining serving and ex-serving veterans and family members in the workplace is a key focus of The Pledge, to ensure successful and meaningful transitions. Training and development is critical to increasing retention levels and supporting meaningful, long-term careers. Workplace programs that encourage and develop serving and ex-serving veterans and their families will be celebrated to enable long-term employment through the Soldier On Pathways Program.

Examples include:

Coaching Programs e.g. career or life coaching to assist in supporting military to civilian transitions

Buddy systems

Mentoring program including involvement in Soldier On and Boeing Australia Mentoring Program

Provide flexible work practices and leave policies

Develop a veteran Employee Resource Group to provide channels and opportunities for veterans working within your organisation to connect

Veteran and family-specific onboarding and career development paths

Leadership development programs

Wellness programs including physical, mental and work-life balance and fitness

Growth opportunities to ensure veterans are aware and have access to opportunities to grow professionally

Ongoing training and development plans with open communication channels

Develop responsive performance feedback mechanisms



Workplace culture and communication

Building organisational knowledge and understanding of The Soldier On Pledge and veteran communities will help serving and ex-serving veterans and their families integrate and feel valued. Soldier On provides regular opportunities for every Pledge Partner to learn about the veteran community, including attendance at Soldier On events and fundraising campaigns.

Opportunities include:

Sponsorship of Soldier On or specific program

Donate to Soldier On, as veterans are hired as part of your organisation's Pledge

Hosting a fundraising event with proceeds to go to Soldier On

Being part of March On, Soldier On's premier fundraising campaign

Attending or sponsoring Soldier On Gala Events in Canberra, Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, and/or Adelaide

Committing your organisation to workplace giving to Soldier On

Engage in staff education and training to bring awareness and appreciation to veterans, their service and sacrifice, which helps to develop a culture where veterans are understood

Actively engage in training and information to address inaccurate veteran stereotypes and stigma

Soldier On's Pathways team is able and available to assist companies with developing and shaping any recruitment, retention or workplace culture strategies and processes to support veteran and family employment. How to become a Pledge Partner

Organisations wishing to sign The Pledge must apply via The Soldier On Pledge application form at pathways.soldieron.org.au/the-pledge/ and highlight how their company provides veteran-friendly recruitment and retention initiatives and workplace culture. Companies applying for Platinum or Gold demonstrate their ongoing commitment to Soldier On with an annual minimum \$2,000 subscription, which also gets the organisation access to the new Soldier On Job Portal. An annual minimum of \$1,500 subscription is required for Silver and \$0 for Bronze, with donations encouraged.

Pledge Partner responsibilities

While membership is non-binding, Soldier On encourages every Pledge Partner to lead from the top, including designating a senior business representative as an Industry Champion to share with staff the organisation's commitment to supporting the veteran community. It is expected this Industry Champion will work with Soldier On's Pathways team as part of each organisation's commitment to support veterans and their families.

Where Soldier On connects each Pledge Partner with job applicants via its Pathways Program, and the candidate is not successful, it is requested that feedback is provided by The Pledge Partner to help improve future applications.

Recognising corporate leadership

The four-tiered program will continue to celebrate member organisations who are making a tangible difference in helping serving and ex-serving veterans and their families transition to civilian careers.

Platinum, Gold, Silver and Bronze Pledge Partner levels demonstrate to Australia's veteran community that signatories are serious about supporting and employing them, promoting positive workplace culture and a commitment to diversity and inclusion.

How to apply

1 Apply

Complete the Application Form, which includes a self-assessment of processes and practices in your organisation which support veteran and family recruitment, retention and culture. 2 Evaluation

Soldier On's Pathways team will evaluate each Application Form, and support each organisation through the process. **3** Notification

If successful, organisations will receive formal notification, Pledge Kits, and ongoing support throughout our relationship.

4 Connect

The Pledge companies will be invited and encouraged to attend Soldier On and Pathways events to continue demonstrating commitment, alignment and support of veterans and families' employment.

Pledge Partner levels



Platinum Pledge Partner | Annual minimum \$2,000 subscription

A Soldier On Platinum Pledge Partner will have demonstrated outstanding results in all three focus areas: recruitment, retention and workplace culture. Additionally they will have a history of being part of the Soldier On Pathways Program and as part of The Pledge commit to an annual minimum \$2,000 subscription to Soldier On. In recognition, every Soldier On Platinum Pledge Partner will receive:

A Soldier On Platinum Pledge Partner digital marketing pack including virtual Platinum Pledge Partner seal, certification, and approved marketing templates for social media;

Bronze Pledge Partner | Free
